

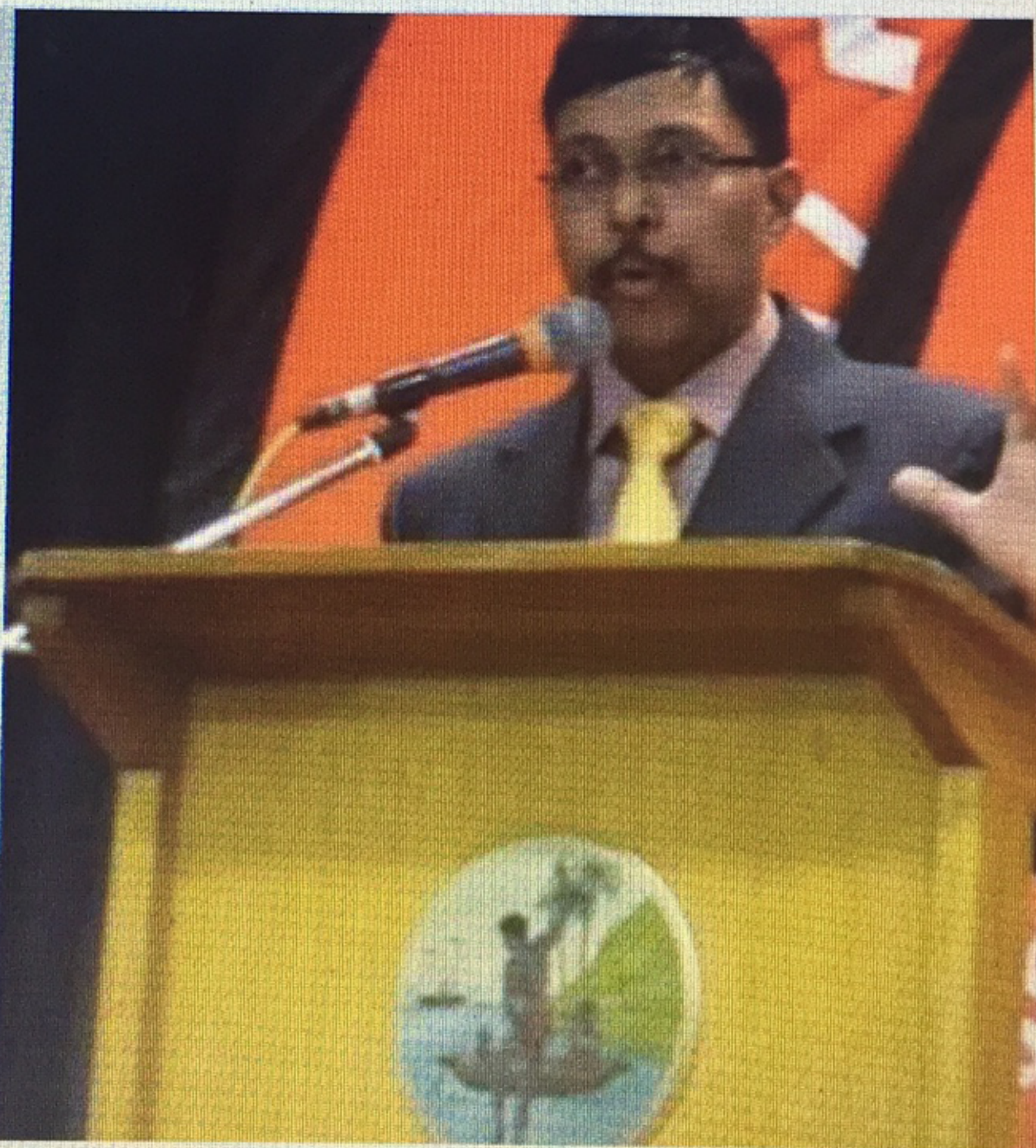
Ganesh Loke
